1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They allow the site to recognise your device and remember information about your visit.

2. How We Use Cookies

Biskops uses a minimal set of cookies needed to operate the service, keep you signed in, remember your language preference, and measure aggregate usage.

3. Categories

Strictly necessary: authentication, security, load balancing. Preferences: language, display options. Analytics: anonymous usage statistics.

4. Third Parties

We use Google for optional sign-in. If you choose Google sign-in, Google may set its own cookies under its own policy.

5. Managing Cookies

You can control cookies in your browser settings. Blocking strictly necessary cookies may break sign-in and core features.

6. Changes
